### **Job fair to hire summer students**

**Windsor Ont. June 9 --** A job fair will be held on Pelissier Street to hire students as summer employees for several Windsor businesses.

The job fair will be held in the Windsor Pride Community, Education and Resource Centre on Saturday, June 11, from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. but the job search will continue through the week. The Pelissier Street Farmer's Market will be happening at the same time. Students must be entering or returning to post-secondary school and can apply for jobs with three different organizations.
